Camping Le Petit Lac Rules

Driving: The driving speed at Camping Le Petit Lac is 5 km per hour, please don't go faster and tell your friends or family who come to visit as it seems they are the ones who go a bit too fast. If there is anyone who needs reminded about our new speed limits, please come and let us know.

Vehicles at the beach: No vehicles allowed on the beach, including cars, trucks, ATV, scooters, motorcycles, etc.

Garbage: All garbage must be in black, green or white plastic garbage bags and well tied, do not use shopping bags etc. as they will not be taken. Furthermore no other objects can be placed in the bin; if it isn't in an approved garbage bag then you cannot throw it out.

Recycling: We will be getting a blue steel bin beside the green bins this is only use for recycling as we want to encourage recycling. You won't need any bags but make sure it is cleaned.

Landscaping, construction, trees: Please note that any and all construction i.e. decks gazebos, walls, paths, lighting, satellites etc. must be approved by property owners. Maximum deck size is equal to the length of your trailer minus 8 feet. Maximum shed size is 8x8. Any unapproved work may have to be removed. All tree and branch cutting must also be approved by owners.

Pets (dogs & cats): We accept small pets and you must control them, example: they have to stay on your lot either by a fence or tied up. You are required to "poop and scoop", failure to do so will result in your pet not being accepted in the campground any longer. You can walk your pet on a leash and excessive barking will not be tolerated.

Grass: Grass cutting and trimming between 10:00 am and 5:00 pm. Each camper is responsible for the maintenance of their lot. If you are incapable of taking care of your lot, additional fees will be charged for the maintenance by the owners. Please see the owners to make arrangements.

Music: All music must be turned off by 11:00 pm. The basic rule is respect for your neighbour.

Satellite: Satellites must be mounted on trailers, or on a post and not on a tree.

ATV: No driving personal ATV on the camping grounds. ATV must be parked at the boat parking area.

Boats and trailers: All boats and trailers must be parked along the back fence.

Departures: In the event of a trailer being sold or moved, lot fees are non refundable and the seller's access rights to the campground are therefore terminated. If the buyer wishes to continue camping at the lot, please advise the owners immediately following the sale of the camper. The owners reserve the right to accept or refuse the buyer's right to have the previous owner's lot for camping.

Lighting: We ask you to be conscientious with your lighting. No new lights allowed unless approved. Landscape lighting or lights on a timer must be solar-powered or low wattage only. Additional fees for hydro usage will be charged to all campers not respecting this rule. All outdoor lights must be turn off at 11:00 pm. Please do not use nails or wire in trees to tie lights, a good alternative could be bungee straps, etc.

Appliances: Electric heaters, dishwashers and dryers are not allowed on the lot or in the trailers.

Visitors: Guest will be charged \$5.00 per guest per night. All visitors will be required to register at the office upon their arrival.

2010 Opening and Closing dates

Opening:

Friday May 07, 2010 if weather permits – entrance gate unlocked, power and water turned on.

Closing:

Camping ends **Sunday October 10, 2010**. No camping after this date.

Camping Fees 2010

Seasonal fee (\$1,100 + tax): **\$1,241.63**

Deposit (\$200 + tax): **\$225.75**

Payment due September 20, 2009

Balance due after deposit: **\$1,015.88**

Payment due May 9, 2010.

No refunds will be given for the winter storage or lot reservation fees.

Conditions:

-Deposit will be applied to the 2010 camping fee

-Campers not returning must remove their trailers by no later than September 20, 2009.
